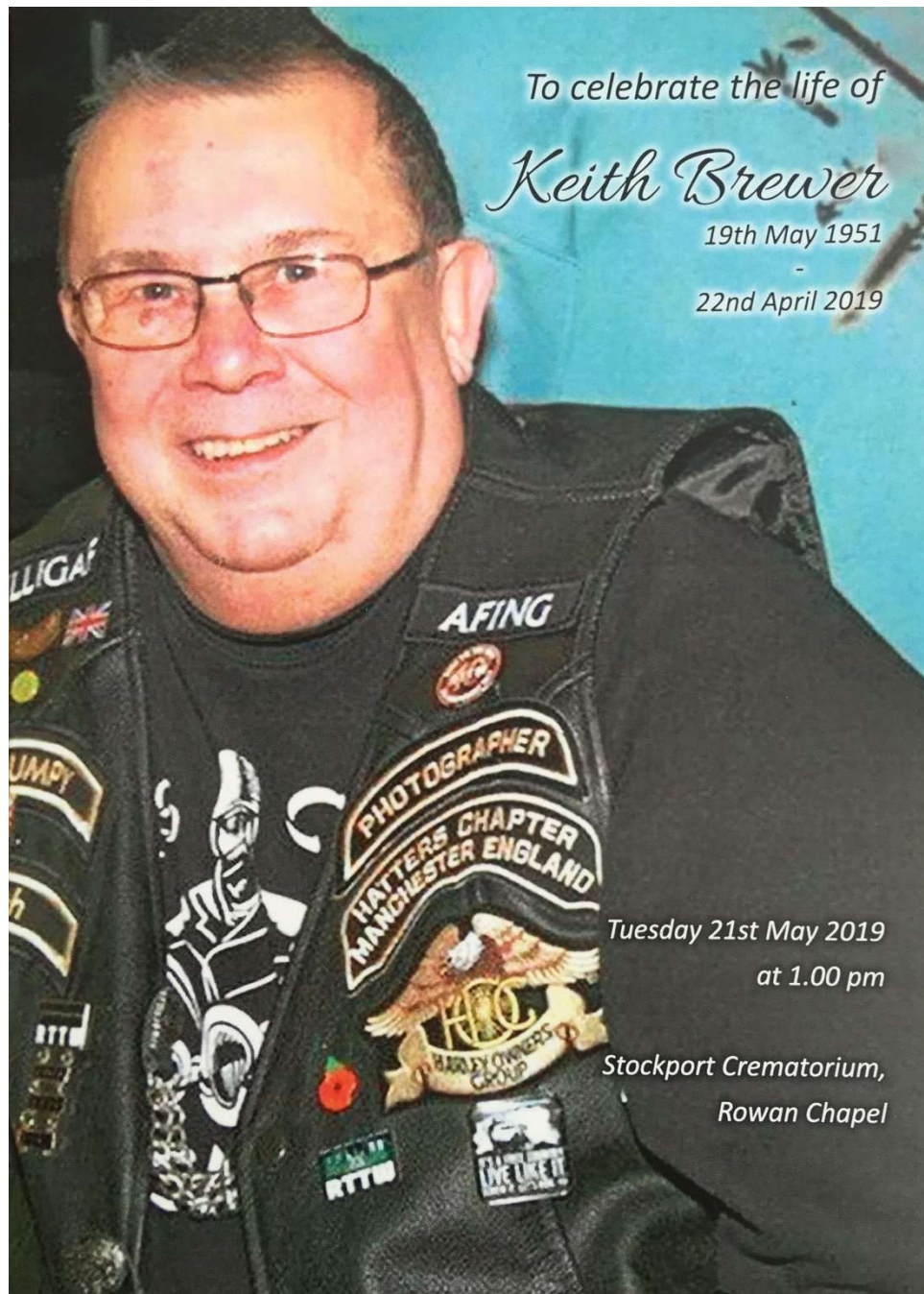


k21 MAY 2019 - GRUMPY'S LAST RIDE
